

MINUTES of a meeting of Cradley Parish Council Planning Committee held on Tuesday 9th July 2013 in Cradley Village Hall commencing at 7pm.

MINUTES – The Minutes of the Planning meeting held on 11th June 2013 were taken as read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – None received.

The following applications had been received for consideration –

8 Oaklands, Cradley – proposed single storey rear extension and internal alterations – **no objections** although Clerk to comment on the positioning of the notice advertising this applications was positioned a long way from the property concerned.

Sundown Lodge, Cradley – remove dying conifer in hedge close to overhead power lines, remove conifer which blocks light to raised bed vegetable garden, tidy and remove dead trees and shrubs from hedgerow and replace removed trees with fruit trees, all work to trees in conservation area – **no objections raised.**

The Chairman reported that the planning applications for Westfields had been approved, a conservatory at Redbrook has been approved, Tudor Cottage removal of conditions have been approved and that some changes regarding the development at Dragonwyck had been refused.

There being no further business the Chairman declared the planning meeting closed at 7.30pm.
