The ideal candidate will be physically fit, have experience of safety and hazard identification and also enjoy working outdoors. You will be expected to use your own suitable vehicle and equipment, and have public liability insurance.

Duties include:

- **Verge cutting**
- **Hedge and Fence Management** - Arrange cutting back of overgrown hedges encroaching on footways. Strim overgrowth along footpaths and recreation areas
- **Drainage** - Clear leaves and other debris from gully grid tops, drainage grips and entrances and exits of highway culverts
- **Minor Storm Debris & Litter** - Clear minor storm debris discharged onto the highway and keep tidy all specified roads.
- **Non-Mains Powered Traffic Signs** - Ensure legibility and visibility of traffic signs including straightening, cleaning and removing vegetation. Repaint traditional finger and mileposts to help preserve local heritage and character

You will be able to work flexibly for approximately 6-7 hours per week. We are seeking applications detailing experience, qualifications and a proposed hourly rate.
